




Functions of mentoring

The workshop was taken by Madam Bonani Dhar the Chairperson WDC. The participants enjoyed the workshop, it was very interactive and engaging.







The workshop would be very informative for students as well as faculty members. By this workshop all can be save themselves to become a victim.














Analysis of the feedback and action taken
