Risk Management mechanisms are designed to identify, assess, mitigate, and monitor the risks associated with AI deployment. The unpredictable nature of Al systems, especially those based on machine learning, presents unique risks that traditional risk management approaches may not fully addressed.

 Among the leading efforts to establish standardized approaches to Al governance developed by the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), USA and regulatory efforts by the European Union (EU). Both the frameworks provide comprehensive guidelines aimed at promoting ethical Al development, mitigating risks, and ensuring compliance with legal and societal standards.
